- Scrap wood either unused or unsuitable for use in our premium windows and doors is put to good use in heating 40% of our manufacturing facility
- All pine products are built from wood harvested locally in New Brunswick SFI (Sustainable Forestry Innitiative) certified forests.
- Any excess or broken glass is collected and returned to our supplier for immediate recycling
- Sawdust is collected in silos, compressed and re-purposed to heat our dry lumber kilns
- All cardboard and paper waste associated with our operations is recycled on a weekly basis.
- All of our windows and doors contain a minimum of 12% recycled material
